Silver – Teachings

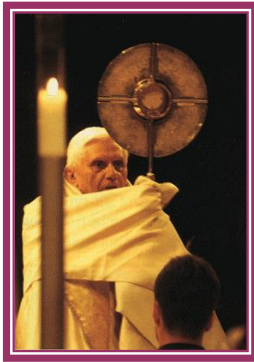
Green – Private Revelation

Saturday : 7 a.m. – midnight
Sunday : 10 a.m. – midnight
- ❖ Formal Prayers in the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel :
Monday – Friday : 7:30 a.m. – 8 a.m. : Rosary
Saturday : 9:00 – 10:00 a.m. Rosary and Cenacle
Daily : 3:00 p.m. : Divine Mercy Chaplet
- ❖ We need Holy Hour Adorers for the following hours :
Wednesday 11:00 a.m. – Noon
Wednesday 11:00 p.m. – Midnight
Saturday 9:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.
Sunday 2:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.
Sunday 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

In addition, we need more Holy Hour Adorers for all hours so that there are at least 2 persons per hour. Reasons Why We Do Eucharistic Adoration!

Jesus says it's an incredible honour
