From the Pulpit

It truly is a busy time of year. There are a lot of important events going on in the next week or so here at St. Ignatius and so I thought it would be good to notify you of these activities so that you can plan for it in your calendars. After all, I'm sure you won't want to miss out on all the fun.

This Monday, December 8th, is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. Therefore, we will have Mass at 7:00 am and at 6:00 pm., followed by a novena immediately after the 6:00 Mass. Also on Friday, December 12, we will be celebrating the feast day of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Our Lady of Guadalupe is the patroness of the Americas, and so it is very appropriate for us to honor her and ask for her intercessory prayers. Mass on that day will also be at 7:00 am and 6:00 pm. As we prepare for Christmas, this is a great time to reflect on the importance of Mary as she plays a very key role in the Christmas story by bringing forth our Savior. To this day, Mary can also play that role in our spiritual lives by continually bringing forth Jesus to us.

On Tuesday, December 9th, we will be having a Communal Reconciliation Service. The Communal Reconciliation Service, which will also include individual confession and absolution, will begin at 7:00 pm. Fr. Alex and myself will be there for the service in addition to another priest from Canada who is here on vacation, Fr. Peter Timmins. If you see him, be sure to thank him for graciously offering to help us out.

In addition to the Communal Reconciliation Service, we will also be adding on some more times for private confession. On Thursday the 18th, I will be hearing confessions in our confessional from 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm. On Monday the 22nd, Fr. Alex will be hearing confessions from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm. And on Tuesday the 23rd, Fr. Alex and myself will be hearing confessions beginning at 6:00 pm. If none of these times work, you can always go on Saturdays at 5:00 pm or just pull one of us aside for confession. We're happy to help.

Finally on Sunday, December 14th, we will be having our parish Christmas Lunch immediately following the 11:30 Mass over at Loyola Hall. Last year I was glad to see that there were a fair amount of people who came to our Christmas Lunch. It was a joyful event and so therefore I encourage you all to come again to this Lunch and join in on the fun. Please see this bulletin for more details.

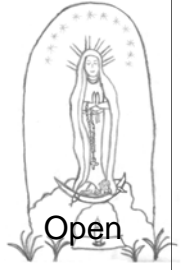

This Week....

We are to be comforted by the promise that the day will come when valleys, hills and hiding places that separate and divide humankind will be removed, and we will live in unity with one another and God. We are called to comfort people with this hope, and to help prepare this way for our God even in the midst of the pain and suffering that is still with us.

For Your Reflection....

Waiting for Christmas is hard. It is hard to wait for anything. But it is especially frustrating to wait for something when you don't know how long it will take or what is holding up- for example, driving along on a busy highway and coming upon a traffic jam that cannot be explained. As far as you can see there is no accident, no construction, no reason for all four lanes to be at a standstill. But if you have been in a situation long enough, you have seen what almost always happen. So sooner or later people start trickling out their cars to talk to one another. They start sharing food, telling stories, getting acquainted, and cracking jokes. Suddenly the waiting doesn't seem like such torture. Why? Because people begin to comfort one another. And who usually starts it? Young people! How does attitude affect waiting and even pain? How does comfort affect attitude? When have you been comforted by a friend or a family member? What words helped? What actions helped? What did he or she try to do to you? Have you ever been able to be of comfort to another? What have you done or said? What happened?
