Jesus spoke with Authority

In today's Gospel reading (Mark 1:21-28) the Sacred Writer, speaks about the authority of the Lord. Jesus begins to teach in Capernaum. The people are held spellbound because he spoke with authority, not like the scribes. A man comes before Jesus who is in the hand of the power of evil. Jesus makes the evil come out of the man. The bystanders are amazed because Jesus has such authority.

The way Jesus exercised His authority is quite different from the way the Scribes and the Pharisees used their authority. The Scribes and the Pharisees used their authority to dominate, control, overpower and to criticize while Jesus' way of using His authority was to empower, to encourage, to forgive and to heal. In the synagogues Jesus didn't just preach; He healed people's tortured minds and bodies; he restored their strength to them. His authority was based on love, integrity and truth.

Jesus spoke the word of God as one spoken it before. When the Rabbis taught, they supported their statements with quotes from other authorities. Even the Prophets spoke with delegated authority saying: *Thus says the Lord*. When Jesus spoke, He needed no authorities to back His statements. He was authority incarnate – the Word of God made flesh. When He spoke God spoke. When He commanded, even demons obeyed.

Jesus did not disrespect the Scriptures; He used them for their intended purpose, to set people free, not to tie them up. "To be ignorant of the Scriptures is to be ignorant of Christ," wrote St. Jerome. We could add that the converse is equally true: to be ignorant of Christ is to be ignorant of the Scriptures.

In what way am I helping the children I know grow in amazement at Jesus and his love for them? When God's Word and God's ways are taught and spoken about with authority - with conviction - our children (and others) will see with amazement God's love for them in his Son Jesus.

SUNDAY REFLECTION Cleansing the Unclean Spirit

This Week....

Moses speaks of another prophet that God will raise up, and Paul speaks of being completely dedicated to the service of God. "When Jesus comes along, and people are amazed at his words and deeds, His first act of power in Marks's Gospel is to make clean the people with unclean spirits.

For Your Reflection.....

Jesus is teaching in the synagogue, and people are impressed with his sense of authority. Jesus is "real". He isn't preachy or arrogant or standoffish or churchy" He speaks at their level, he makes sense, he believes in what he is saying, and he doesn't want to play games with prestige or status. Do you know any teacher at school who have that gift? Do you know any leaders in your community or your church who are like that? Describe an adult you can relate to, one who is "real". Jesus cleaned the unclean. He recognized the unclean, he knew what clean and unclean were all about, and he took action and made a difference. Anytime we clean anything, we take those same steps. We have to recognize the need to clean, we have to know what clean looks like, and we have to take action so that the unclean becomes clean. What is something you have cleaned that took quite a bit of work? Anytime we have a personal problem we need to clean up, or a bad habit we need to cure, take the same basic cleaning steps. What personal cleaning have you done for yourself? What prompted you to act? Sometimes personal cleaning comes as a surprise. It can happen when something difficult challenges us or something sad moves us or something awesome inspire us. Has that ever happened to you?
