From the Paulpit

We were a little worried at first when we found out that the Young Leaders event was the same night, but fortunately we still had a good turn out and a great time was had by all. After it was all said and done we netted somewhere in the vicinity of \$43,000 towards the building of Stella Maris in Cayman Brac. Now that doesn't mean we still haven't got more money to raise, but this definitely was very helpful.

There were certainly a lot of people who did a lot of work behind the scenes to help make this auction possible. Whether it was procuring or donating items, or setting up for the auction, or helping out on the night of the auction itself. There are so many people to thank, I would hate to leave anyone out. Therefore, I just wanted to use this occasion then to thank everyone who helped in any way to make this auction a successful fund raiser for Stella Maris. I also wanted to thank those who attended our auction and those who have supported us in our efforts to raise money to have this church built on Cayman Brac. Your generosity is much appreciated.

Now that Lent is here, it is time for us to schedule some extra things for your spiritual growth. This Tuesday, March 3rd at 7:00, we are going to have a Communal Reconciliation Service with individual Confession and Absolution. I know it is early in Lent to do this service, but this is the only date that I have four priests available (including myself) to hear confessions. If you can't make this service then don't worry, there will be several more times scheduled for private confession the closer we get to Holy Week.

Another spiritual exercise that we will be doing during Lent is the Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 5:30, just before Mass at 6:00. And of course don't forget our Friday fish fry at the school canteen from 5 until 8, which won't actually begin until March 6th. Our fish fry is world famous, people from all over the world come to eat our fish, so you don't want to miss it. Especially because Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence, if you are going to eat fish, you might as well do it here. The price is better than any restaurant you can find in town.

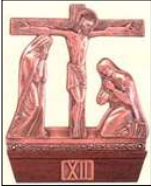


Holy Father's Prayer Intention for March 2009

Lent is a season of soul-searching and repentance. It is a season for reflection and taking stock. Lent originated in the very earliest days of the Church as a preparatory time for Easter, when the faithful rededicated themselves and when converts were instructed in the faith and prepared for baptism. By observing the forty days of Lent, the individual Christian imitates Jesus' withdrawal into the wilderness for forty days. All churches that have a continuous history extending before AD 1500 observe Lent.

GOSPEL REFLECTIONS

Gospel Summary

Jesus trusted in God's promises. According to Mark's gospel, immediately after his baptism, Jesus was driven into the wilderness where he lived with the wild beasts for forty days and was tempted by Satan. Through those desolate days, Jesus was faithful to God. And at the end of the forty days, the angels came to minister to Jesus.

Reflection for Families

If you have ever sat with a sick child, you know the relief that comes when a fever breaks or the pox scab and the corner of the child's mouth turns up into a long awaited smile. This must have been something of what Jesus felt at the end of his stay in the desert and it is what we feel when have been faithful to our Lenten efforts.

Bringing the Gospel into Your Family

This year as you begin Lent, talk as a family about why the Holy Spirit took Jesus into the wilderness and why he stayed there forty days. It is likely you will name things such as prayer, quiet time for reflection, doing God's will, and more. As you consider what individual members or the whole family may do in the way of Lenten practices this year, use Jesus as a model. Keep in mind that the hardships of others may be much greater than your own. Like the angels who came to Jesus' side at the end of the forty days, perhaps your family can attend to the needs of someone else.
