From the Pulpit

This coming Saturday, the 28th, we will be having a Lenten Day of Recollection. The theme of this day of recollection is, "A Call to Conversion." Not only is this theme appropriate for Lent, but it is also a fitting topic with the Pauline Year as well. This day of recollection will kind of be like a mini-retreat. We will begin with Mass at 8:30 am, and then start off with some prayer and then a talk. There will also be time for silent prayer and reflection, as well as group discussion. We will end with Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction around 3:00 pm. Lunch will be provided, and the sacrament of Reconciliation will be available too.

Concerning the presenters on this "mini-retreat," I will be giving a talk along with Mr. Andrew Egan, our primary school principal. Fr. Alex doesn't know it yet, but he is going to give a talk as well. He comes back from India this weekend, so I am sure he will have a lot of interesting things to talk about. If you would like to come, please notify us by signing up on the sign up sheet, or call the office. We just need to know approximately how many people will be coming so that we can plan accordingly for lunch.

I encourage you if you at all possibly can, to come to this day of recollection. I am sure it will be good for your soul. As a priest, I am required to go on a retreat once a year for the sake of my own spiritual growth and mental well being. But priests aren't the only ones who need these things. Seeing as how we are all called to holiness, all of us should really take some time every year to get away and do some kind of a retreat where you can just stop and reflect and spend some time with the Lord. This day of recollection is your chance, take advantage of it.

We have some additional times scheduled for private confession in the next couple of weeks leading up to the Easter Triduum. Private confession will be offered on Thursday, April 2nd at 6:00 pm; Friday, April 3rd at 5:00 pm; Tuesday, April 7th at 6:00 pm; and Wednesday, April 8th at 6:00 pm. If you can't make one of those times, or the regularly scheduled confession time on Saturdays at 5:00, then feel free to make an appointment with Fr. Alex or myself.

This Sunday, the fourth Sunday of Lent, is sometimes known as Laetare Sunday. Laetare is a Latin word which means rejoice, and as far as I can tell, means the same thing as gaudete. Gaudete Sunday of course is celebrated on the third Sunday of Advent in anticipation of Christmas. The fourth Sunday of Lent is called Laetare Sunday because Laetare is the first word in the introit at the beginning of Mass, and because there is supposed to be a joyful tone in anticipation of the fact that Easter Sunday will soon be upon us. Because of this joyful tone, this Sunday and Gaudete Sunday are the only two Sundays where rose colored vestments are permitted to be worn. Of course, our Director of Religious Education, Mr. O'Neil Miller, likes to tease me about wearing pink (rose), but truth be told, I think he is just jealous.

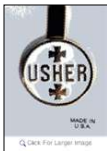

GOSPEL REFLECTIONS

Gospel Summary

God's love is clearly demonstrated in this gospel reading. Some people of Jesus' time had shallow faith and would believe only if they saw signs of God's power. Jesus helped his listeners recall an event in which God instructed Moses to lift up a bronze serpent. Anyone who looked at the snake would be cured of poisonous bites. In the gesture of "lifting up" Jesus projected his own glory. God loved the world so much that he sent his own son. He did this to make clear to us how very much God loves us and wants to provide salvation for all of us who have failed.

Reflection for Families

It is not hard for parents to understand how much God loves his people. No matter how many times we have to discipline, guide, and correct our children, our love never diminishes. We know that our efforts and energy are shaping them into the best people they can be. We only need to show them the light of God's way and walk with them in that light.

Bringing the Gospel Into Your Family

Think of someone in your family who might be experiencing a time of darkness; a time when it might be hard for them to understand that God really loves them. Think together of a way your family can reach out to that person by sending a card, making a phone call, or sharing friendship with them.
