From the Pulpit

Alelluia! The Lord has risen! This piece of news is most definitely a joyful one because it has everything to do with our own eternal salvation. Just think, because of Jesus, we know that death no longer has power over us. We know that we can have a share in Jesus' resurrection, and his kingdom. As long as we remain connected to him, the victory is ours!

Next Sunday the 19th, otherwise known as 'Divine Mercy Sunday', there will be a lot going on. First of all, at 9:15 am that morning, we are going to have a special guest speaker, Dr. Ruppertsberger, who will give us a presentation on Natural Family Planning and marriage. I highly encourage any and all adults, especially married couples, to attend this presentation. Sadly, many people choose to ignore, or purposely tune out whatever the church might have to say on this issue, and they do so to their own detriment. I can just about guarantee with 99% probability that unless you have attended this presentation before, you don't know exactly what or why the church teaches what it teaches in regards to Natural Family Planning and birth control. We can't just bury our heads in the sand and pretend it isn't there. We need to thoroughly understand this issue and arm ourselves with as much information as possible so that we can be sure that we are doing everything we can to strengthen our marriages and obey God's commands. Therefore, if it is at all possible for you to attend this presentation, please do so, it isn't every Sunday that we can put this on. This is your opportunity to be further educated in your faith and to improve your marriage (if you are in fact married). After all, who doesn't need these things?

Also on Sunday the 19th, we will be doing Baptisms again after not having them during Lent, and so we have quite a few lined up at 1:00. After the baptisms, we will be doing our Divine Mercy Devotion. Many graces and mercy is promised to those who do this devotion on Divine Mercy Sunday. All that is required is that you make your confession beforehand, receive the Eucharist that Sunday, and then attend the devotion if possible, which will begin at 2:30, includes a Holy Hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament, and will conclude around 3:15. This is a beautiful devotion that is good for the soul and worth your while to attend. Therefore, I encourage you to come if you can.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Gospel Summary

On Friday afternoon when Jesus died, the women had not been able to finish the customary preparation for burial. The Sabbath began at sundown on Friday, so Mary of Magdala hurried to the tomb Sunday morning to complete her task. She found the tomb empty. Certain that Jesus' body had been stolen she ran back to get the other disciples. Peter and the other disciples also found an empty tomb but with Jesus' clothing rolled neatly and placed where his body had been. The disciples still didn't understand about the resurrection and Mary wept. As she cried, two angels appeared asking why she was crying. She then saw a gardener and asked him where the body might be. When he called her by name, Mary immediately recognizes Jesus.

Reflection for Families

Most parents have discovered by now that things aren't always as they seem. A poured out bottle of laundry detergent wasn't really mischievous behavior, but rather an attempt to surprise you with a generous gift of service. Or secret whispers are not an attempt to hide some wrongdoing but rather an effort to plan a surprise for you. Things weren't as they seemed to Mary Magdalene either that first Easter morning. Our errors in perception often work to remind us that God's plan is not always obvious, but that we are challenged to trust in the promise of the resurrection.
