From the Pulpit

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. In doing so we are reminded that Jesus entered fully into our human condition and sanctified all that is good in it, including family life.

The Christian faith has always strongly upheld the sanctity of the family and its importance for society and the Church. According to the Catechism, "...the family is the original cell of social life... Authority, stability, and a life of relationships within the family constitute the foundations for freedom, security, and fraternity within society. The family is the community in which, from childhood, one can learn moral values, begin to honor God, and make good use of freedom." (no. 2204)

What the Catechism is saying is that the family is part of our God-given constitution as human beings. It is within the family that people receive their first lessons in social virtues which are important in the existence and development of society itself. The family is the first and irreplaceable school of social life. The family is the most effective means for humanizing and personalizing society because of the family's unique role in guarding and transmitting virtues and values.

When it comes down to it, the family has the mission to protect, reveal, and communicate love, because this is really the number one place where we first and foremost learn how to develop deep, personal, and intimate relationships with each other and with God. If this doesn't happen within the family, then problems arise. When families begin to break down, then society suffers, and if enough families fall apart, then so does society. This is why we need to make a concerted effort in strengthening the traditional family. It might seem like all of this is obvious, but the sad fact of the matter is that in the West, not only have we witnessed the break down of large numbers of families through divorce, but the family is also being redefined to mean any number of things. When this happens, children are then put at a disadvantage in developing into healthy well-adjusted adults. This is why our faith needs to have a central role in our family life because if we are going to follow the example of the Holy Family: Jesus, Mary and Joseph, then we need God's help. We have to learn how to imitate their complete willingness to do God's will, rather than following one's own selfish whims and desires. If we do that then we can be sure that our families will remain strong, and our society will be healthy for many years to come.

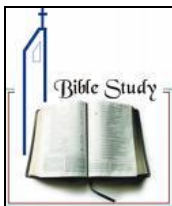
