### From the Pulpit

I hope you all had a chance to attend our world famous fish fry last Friday. If you did, then you know that our fish is the best. If not, then at least you still have the next four Fridays to attend.

But of course, even though this is an important activity that we do during Lent, Lent is much more than fish fries and avoiding meat on Fridays. Lent is a time to enter into oneself. It is a period of particular intimacy with God in the secrecy of one's own heart and conscious. The essential work of Lent is the work of conversion, and such conversion takes place within our interior intimacy with God. Psalm 51 is a prayer towards God, and it speaks volumes: "Have mercy on me, O God, in your goodness; in the greatness of your compassion wipe out my offense. Thoroughly wash me from my guilt and of my sin cleanse me. For I acknowledge my offense and my sin is before me always: Against you only have I sinned, and done what is evil in your sight." The late Pope John Paul II said that these words are purifying words. Transforming words. They transform us within and are a testimony of transformation.

Truth be told, the first step of the spiritual life is self-awareness. That is what Lent is about, taking that first step. You see, most people can fairly easily point out the faults and failings of others, but at the same time, are not very good at identifying and admitting their own. If we are serious about being Christians, then we need to be able and willing to enter into ourselves, to be honest with ourselves, and reconcile with God the things that we do, say or think that needs to be amended. This is why reconciliation is such an important sacrament, especially this time of year. It truly helps us to repair and strengthen our relationship with our Lord. Therefore, I encourage you to make use of this sacrament during this season of Lent, and renew and transform your relationship with God.

### SUNDAY REFLECTION

Peter, Andrew and James were blessed to see the Transfigured Lord in their own eyes. Speaking about these extraordinary moments of insight and revelation, which not only these three disciples, but many others experience during their earthly pilgrimage with God, Pope Benedict said: 'When one has the grace to sense a strong experience of God, it is as though seeing something similar to what the disciples experienced during the Transfiguration: For a moment they experienced ahead of time something that will constitute the happiness of paradise. In general, it is brief experiences that God grants on occasions, especially in anticipation of harsh trials. However, no one lives "on Tabor" while on earth. Human existence is a journey of faith and, as such, goes forward more in darkness than in full light, with moments of obscurity and even profound darkness. While we are here, our relationship with God develops more with listening than with seeing; and even contemplation takes place, so to speak, with closed eyes, thanks to the interior light lit in us by the Word of God.'

The Virgin Mary herself, notwithstanding the fact that she was the human creature closest to God walked day after day as though on a pilgrimage of faith (Lumen gentium 58) keeping and meditating constantly in her heart the word that God addressed her, whether through the sacred Scriptures or through events of her son, in which she recognized and accepted the Lord's mysterious voice. This is, therefore, the gift and commitment for each one of us during the Lenten Season: To Listen to Christ, like Mary.

To listen to him in the word, preserved in sacred Scripture. To listen to him in the very events of our lives, trying to read in them the messages of providence. To listen to him, finally, in our brothers, especially in the little ones and the poor, for whom Jesus himself asked our concrete love. To listen to Christ and to obey his voice. This is the only way that leads to joy and love.' (Spoken during the saying of the Angelus, 13 March 2006)
