From the **Paul**pit

Have you seen the thermometer at the entrance of the church? If you take a look at it, you'll notice that there is something a little bit different about it. What's different about it is that this thermometer doesn't actually measure the temperature, instead it measures how much we have raised towards the building of the church in Cayman Brac.

As I am sure you all know, the new Catholic church, 'Stella Maris', is presently under construction on the bluff in Cayman Brac. The residents on this island have wanted this church for many years, and now it is actually becoming a reality. Of course, we still are not quite done raising all the funds we need for this project. According to our thermometer, for phase one, which is the church itself, we still need about another \$120,000, and for phase two, which is the rectory, we need about \$150,000.

I know it has been a couple of years since we have had a drive to raise money for the church in Cayman Brac. I also know that some had said that they would donate more money once the construction has started. Well, that time has come, the construction has started and the building is going up fast. In next week's church bulletin, we should have for you a handout that describes the building that is being constructed, and what kind of things that your money will buy for the church (eg. An arch would cost something like \$200).

Therefore, I would ask that you consider giving a generous donation over the next few months. \$120,000 for phase one might sound like a lot, but think about it this way. There are over 6,000 Catholics on this island. More than half of them are employed adults. If just 20% of them gave \$100-\$200 towards the project, we would have most of it raised. Of course if you want to give more, you are welcome and encouraged to do so, I know I will. And if you can't give that much, its ok, any donation of any size is much appreciated. The point is, if we all pitch in what we can, we will have this church paid off in no time. If you want to write a cheque, you can make it out to St. Ignatius Church/ Cayman Brac Building Fund. I thank you in advance for your consideration.
